Journey to Rothenburg



GERMANY TRIP TIPS

PREPARING FOR YOUR ADVENTURE

Required Travel Documentation

If you are a U. S. citizen, you will need a valid passport to enter Germany and return to the United States. It must be valid six months beyond your intended stay and have 1-2 blank pages remaining. Allow yourself sufficient time to have your application processed if you are applying for a new passport or renewing an expired passport. Refer to the U.S. Department of State for further details.

In addition, Guests 17 years of age or younger may be required to show additional documentation when traveling with a single parent.

You do not need a visa to travel to Germany.

If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check with the German Embassy for information on documentation requirements.

Passport/Visa Services

You can apply for a passport and/or visa through CIBT, Inc., a third party travel document company servicing the travel industry (not affiliated withthe Walt Disney Company). Learn more or call CIBT at (800) 406-1523. Be sure to mention Adventures by Disney, account #55134, for special pricing options.

PLEASE NOTE: ADDITIONAL CHARGES WILL APPLY FOR TELEPHONE CALLS made to access CIBT specialists.

What to Pack

Please limit your baggage to 1 piece of luggage per person plus 1 carry-on. With frequent security changes, we recommend that you check with your air carrier as well as with the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for current restrictions.

Since a majority of your adventure will take place outdoors, your attire should be comfortable. Most attire is casual, although one "smart casual butfit is recommended.

EN ROUTE

Arrival/Departure Information

After arriving at Munich Airport (MUC), you may pass through Immigration and Passport Control. This is dependent on your departure city and where your flight connections were. Follow airport signage to Baggage Claim. Retrieve your luggage and exit the Baggage Claim area by passing through Customs and then into the main terminal. As soon as you arrive in the Arrivals Hall of the terminal, look for a representative holding an orange Adventures by Disney sign. This representative is available to assist you with your luggage and will escort you to your prearranged ground transportation to your hotel. At the conclusion of your adventure, you will be transferred from the Regent Berlin to Berlin Tegel International Airport (TXL) for your return flight home.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I book my Adventures by Disney vacation?

If you are in the United States, please call (800) 543-0865† to speak to a Vacationista, or contact your Travel Agent.

If you are outside the United States, please call (866) 983-7872† to speak to a Vacationista, or contact your Travel Agent.

Do I need vaccinations to travel to this country?

If you are a U.S. citizen, you do not need vaccinations to travel to Germany. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check your local requirements on vaccinations for travel to Germany.

What airport do I fly into and out of?

Arrival: We will pick you up from Munich Airport (MUC) on your arrival day. Your flight should arrive no later than 2:00 PM.

Departure: At the end of your adventure, we will transfer you to Berlin Tegel Airport (TXL). Your flight should depart no earlier than 8:00 AM.

Are transfers included if I arrive or depart from different locations or at different times from the itinerary?

No. Transfers are only included from the specified arrival/departure airports and hotels. For Germany, transfers are included from Munich to Kempinski on your arrival day. On your departure day, transfers are included from Regent Berlin to Berlin Tegel Airport (TXL).

Can I extend my vacation beyond the Adventures by Disney itinerary?

Yes, you may stay in Germany before or after our itinerary. Pre/post night stays in Munich and Berlin are available at special rates if booked through Adventures by Disney Travel Services, Inc. in conjunction with a land package and cannot be combined with any other offer. Please contact a Vacationista at (800) 543-0865† for further information.

How will our group travel between destinations?

Your group will travel by motor coach and train between cities and between sites.

How strenuous are the activities?

While this adventure is not considered physically strenuous, most days will include one or more hours of walking, often on uneven ground or cobblestone streets. A number of the destinations require climbing stairs. There is also a bike-riding activity on a gentle, paved path. Many days will have motor coach trips between destinations that last one or more hours. While nearly all of the trip's featured activities are relatively easy if examined separately, the full range of activities requires a moderate amount of stamina in order to get the most of your vacation.



What ages are appropriate for this adventure?

While we welcome children ages 6 and up at the time of travel to discover the stories of the world with us, we recommend that children be at least 8 years old at the time of travel on our Germany trip. This is based on several factors, such as flight time and jet lag, time zone differences in the destination, duration of the vacation and amount of physical activity (e.g., walking, biking) involved. Because each child is different, call al/acationista at (800) 543-0865† to discuss whether this is the right trip for your little kids.

What types of meals are served on this Adventures by Disney Trip?

Typically, breakfast is served buffet style. Dinners and lunches usually include fish, meat (pork is a common option at many meals), and pasta or rice entrées, soup and vegetables, along with desserts and fruit. While the menus have been planned to give you a taste of typical German cuisine, they are always balanced with limited American fare. Some meals on this trip are served buffet style while others offer a limited-choice menu. Given the nature of group travel, we regret that á la carte menu choices are not available. Children-friendly choices are available at all meals. Menu items are subject to change due to the availability and seasonality of foods. In order to offer you and your family a bit of time to enjoy meals among yourselves, there are a few meals that are not included in the itinerary. These meals have been planned in towns or cities where you will have plenty of options available. If you have any questions or concerns about dining at any time during your vacation, your Adventure Guides will be happy to assist you.

Is alcohol included with meals?

Alcoholic beverages are typically not included with your scheduled meals. However, you may purchase them at your own expense.

Can you accommodate special dietary needs?

Adventures by Disney will make a reasonable effort to accommodate some special dietary needs at no additional charge. Is this itinerary appropriate for travelers with special needs?

What if Adventures by Disney cancels the adventure prior to departure?

We will make every reasonable effort to operate the vacations as advertised; however, we reserve the right to curtail or modify the itinerary, or to substitute activities, hotels, meals or transportation as we deem necessary. We further reserve the right to reduce the number of Adventure Guides to one, and to modify other services to accommodate a smaller group, if a minimum number of Guests is not reached. Similarly, we may marginally



exceed the stated group maximum size if necessary to accommodate a family. Please also note that during certain holidays and peak periods, some activities may be disrupted or unavailable. None of these modifications or changes shall affect the land package price. We reserve the right to cancel a trip at any time prior to its commencement for any reason, such as if there are too few Guests, or if the quality of the trip or the safety of the Guests would, in our opinion, be compromised, such as may result from unforeseen circumstances (acts of God) or other circumstances beyond our reasonable control.
